Putting straws in rolled paper with a hole



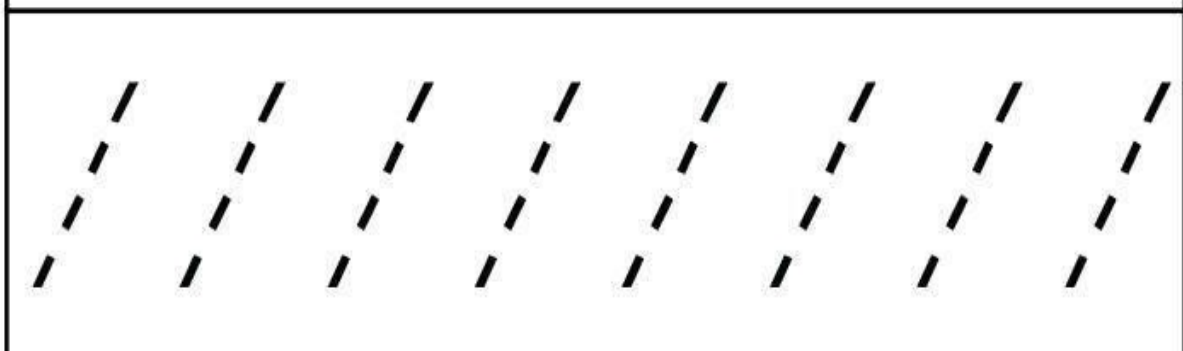
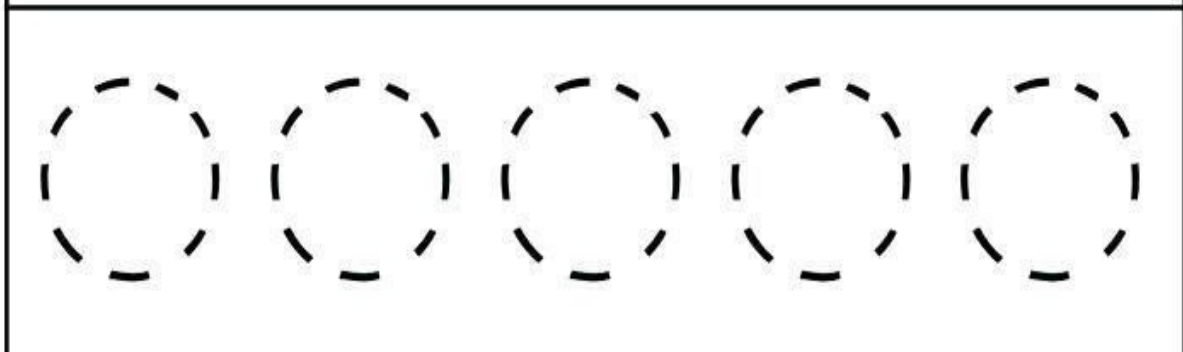
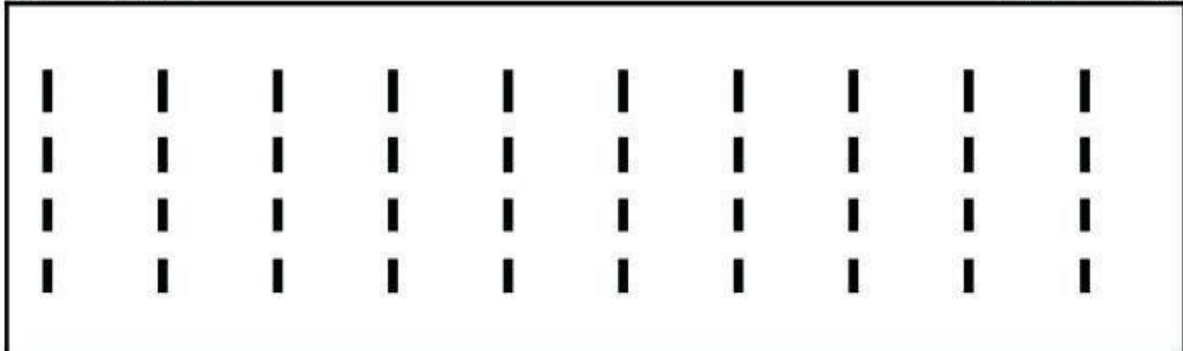
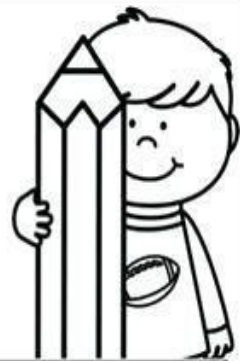

- Encourage your child to speak in English with parents and friends.

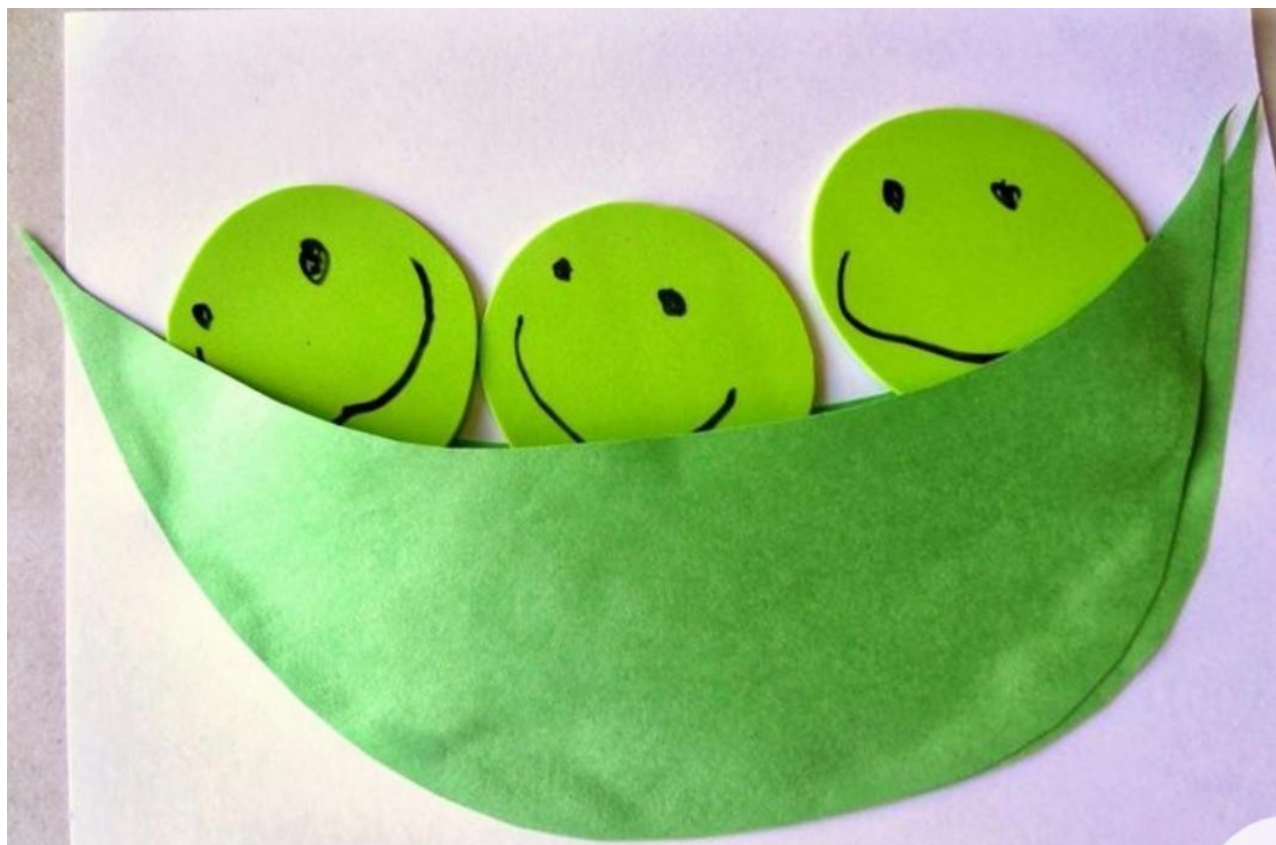
VALUE EDUCATION

USE CHILD FRIENDLY SCISSORS TO CREATE THE SHAPE OF THE FACE OF THE KING OF THE JUNGLE



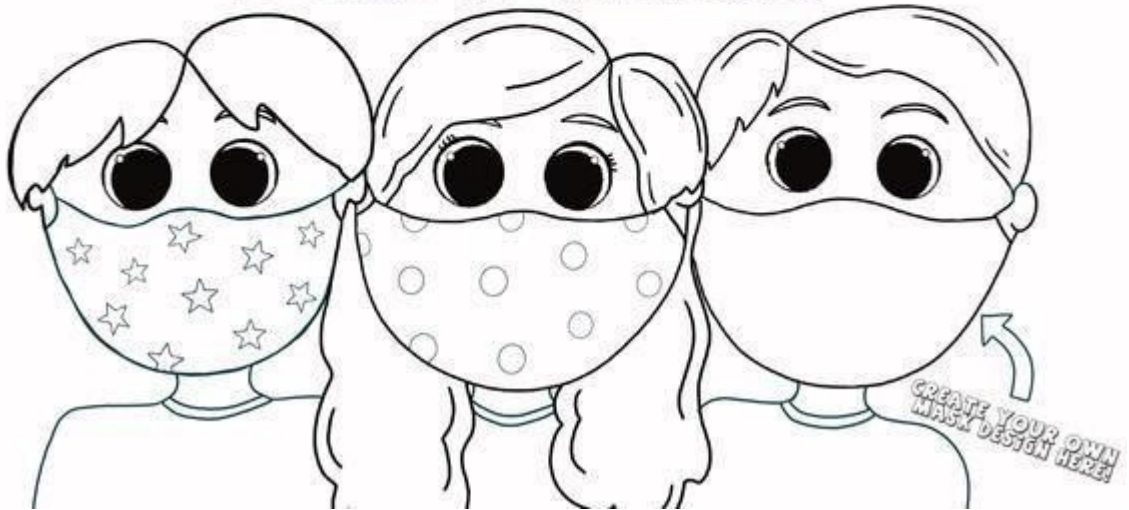
SHOW AND TELL
